To Whom It May Concern,

On February 12, 2013, Jarrett Banks of Wahoo Innovations came to our jobsite with The Light Pole Dancer and assisted us in setting light pole on a pole base located on a sloped embankment. The location was problematic for us, due to the proximity to operational railroad tracks and due to the allowable load limitations on the brick plaza area in front of the embankment.

Jarrett arrived on time and gave our electricians direction to dig out the dirt on the high side of the pole base, so the Light Pole Dancer could be installed on the uphill side of the base, and could be strapped to the base. Within 2 hours (including the digging), Jarrett and two electricians dug the dirt out, assembled and secured the Light Pole Dancer, set the light fixture pole on the concrete base, and disassembled and stowed the Light Pole Dancer base on the pickup truck.

Jarrett demonstrated the use of the Light Pole Dancer as well as the dual-use dolly.

We were very impressed by the Light Pole Dancer and by Jarrett's professionalism. It was clear as Jarrett and the electricians assembled the Light Pole Dancer and moved the light fixture pole into place that using the Light Pole Dancer is both easy to use and easy to assemble and disassemble.

Having seen the Light Pole Dancer used so easily in a difficult setting, we could clearly see that the Light Pole Dancer would be advantageous to use in parking lot settings, as well.
